Apple Pie Baking Contest at Fall Fest

If you are a person who loves to bake and be acknowledged for your efforts, the **Community Hope Fund** is offering you the opportunity to try your skill and luck by entering our apple pie baking contest to be held Saturday, September 25, 2010 (rain date Sept. 26), at Joe Palaia Park in Ocean Township. Profits will benefit Community Hope Fund - a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to promoting youth development and supporting the charitable needs of the Township of Ocean and surrounding communities in New Jersey .

CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

Who May Enter

The contest is open to all Monmouth County residents and businesses.

How to Enter

Participants may apply in the following levels:

Kids (12 and under), **Amateur**, **Professional**

Pie Categories include: **All Apple** or **Apple Mix** (berries, other fruits, nuts)

Contestants may enter the contest by registering at **Ocean Township Human Services Department (610 Deal Road, Ocean, NJ)** no later than September 18th.

Registration fee:

\$10 for Kids/Amateurs, \$20 for Professionals. All participants will be given two 9-inch pie pans and a \$5 Wegmans gift certificate to buy ingredients.

ENTRY FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNTIL SEPTEMBER 18th.

No entries will be accepted after that date.

Rules

Each participant must submit two 9-inch pies (one for the judges and one for the bake sale) and a printed, legible copy of the recipe. All pies must be made from scratch (crust and filling). Published/magazine recipes are acceptable.

Creativity and original ideas are encouraged. Your pies do not have to be a "traditional" two-crust pie. Once submitted, the pies become property of Community Hope Fund. After judging, pies will be sold at the event.

On **Saturday, September 25, 2010**, pies should be brought to Joe Palaia Park (pie contest table in front of bandstand) between 10 a.m. – 12 p.m.

Pies will be judged at 12:30 p.m.



Judging Criteria

Judging will be based on overall appearance, creativity, crust color, flavor, texture, filling-consistency, and doneness. Judging results are confidential.

Overall Appearance	15 points
Creativity of Recipe	25 points
Crust	20 points
Flavor	30 points
Texture	<u>20 points</u>
Total Points	100 Points

Prizes

Winners will be recognized in an award ceremony following the judge's decision at 2 p.m.

Kids: All participating children will receive a certificate & goodie bag

Amateur: 1st Prize = \$150 value of gift certificates
 2nd Prize = \$100 value of gift certificates
 3rd Prize = \$50 value of gift certificates

Professional: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Prize = Certificates
